Recommended uses for Canine Omega Benefits:

1. **Dermatitis:** A double-blinded, placebo-controlled study demonstrated that Canine Omega Benefits significantly decreased pruritus and improved the Canine Atopic Dermatitis Lesion Index (CADLI)¹ in atopic dogs.
2. **Osteoarthritis:** A double-blinded, placebo-controlled study demonstrated that Canine Omega Benefits significantly improved lameness scores, joint effusion, joint crepitus, and joint pain on range of motion, as well as significantly improved joint discomfort in dogs diagnosed with osteoarthritis.
3. **Wellness:** Eighty-eight percent of dogs have an abnormal iFATS (Inflammatory Fatty Acid Target Score). This means that dogs have significantly higher amounts of pro-inflammatory arachidonic acid in their tissues compared to anti-inflammatory levels of EPA and DHA. This imbalance exacerbates any underlying inflammatory disease because excess arachidonic acid provides fuel for the enzymatic creation of inflammatory prostaglandins via the cyclooxygenase (COX) pathway.



Suggestions for talking to your clients about Canine Omega Benefits:

1. **Dermatitis:** Unfortunately, there is no cure for allergies and treatment usually consists of one or a combination of lifelong therapies to keep your pet comfortable. It also enables us to minimize the prescription of pharmaceuticals which can be dangerous for short and long term use in certain patients. It will take up to 3 months for Canine Omega Benefits to have its complete effect in the joints of patients with severe osteoarthritis but positive results are seen within as little as 2 weeks of initiating supplementation.
2. **Wellness:** Your patient looked great today on their physical examination. A topic that many well-educated veterinarians bring up is a new study identifying that greater than 88% of dogs have an imbalanced Omega 6:3 ratio due to the nutritional imbalance found in most pet foods.
